



Let's get to work.

Preparation

- 1. Remove existing guard and clean all surfaces of debris and dirt.
- Use the M8 bolts and nuts to attach the short and long size brackets to the rear of the guard and the medium size bracket (etched FTG120-04D) to the front of the guard, as shown.



Installation

- Prepare six M8 bolts & washers by lubricating the threads using Copper Eze or similar lubricant.
- Loosely install the fuel tank guard to the existing mounting points using the six M8 bolts.
- 3. Tighten all bolts, and you're done!
