

Let's get to work.

Preparation

 We want a nice clean starting surface, so remove any dirt and debris from the mounting surfaces on the shock absorber mount.

Installation of Bottom Brackets

- 1. Attach the bottom bracket using the existing lower shock bolt.
- Secure the other hole using the provided M10 bolt, unistrut nut and washer.
- 3. Tighten all bolts to required torque as per table.





Installation of Shock Guard

- 1. Attach the front guard using the M6 bolts and washers.
- 2. Check position of the guard, and then tighten all bolts to required torque as per table.
- 3. Repeat for the opposite side.
