




It all works together.

Our Out-Back Mounting System is designed to work together, but there is an order to installing based on the mount you are using for your spare wheel.

The following instructions will vary, based on which Out-Back Mount you are using:

Let's get to work.

Preparation

- It's best if we get the mounting pins attached to the Maxtrax Mini Mounts first. If you ordered a set of pins, these will have been included. If you already had some, that's great! If you've lost them, we know a place you can buy some...
- 2. The genuine Maxtrax Mounting
 Pin Set contains 4 x ins, 4 x nyloc
 nuts and 4 x washers. We find it
 easiest to attach the pins to the
 Maxtrax Mini Mounts by holding the
 pin in place with a spanner, while
 using a socket to tighten the nut.
- Ensure the final position of the pin matches the same orientation as the keyholes of your Maxtrax.



Installation

- 4. Attach the Maxtrax Mini Mount to the Spare Tyre Mount. We recommend sitting the mounts up against the tyre to work out what positioning will work best for your setup, ensuring that your rear door or rear bar swingaway are able to open unaffected.
- Secure the Maxtrax Mini Mount to the Spare Tyre Mount using the M8 bolts, nuts and washers.
- Position the Spare Tyre Mount on the tyre, and secure with the provided ratchet strap. We advise ensuring that the hooks are facing outwards with the ratchet at the top of the tyre.
- Carefully double check clearance between the product and vehicle by gently opening the rear door until it's fully open. Failure to do this may result in damage to the product and/or vehicle.
- 8. That's it, you're ready to hit the road!







If you are using a Out-Back Centre Hub Mount, you will need to follow the installation instructions for it, before proceeding with these instructions.

Out-Back Centre Hub Mount Installation

- Decide on a desired location, the Maxtrax Mini mount can be mounted vertically or horizontally, central or offset. Consider things like clearance to the vehicle when the door is shut and open, as well as rear visibility and tow ball access etc.
- 10. Align the holes on the Maxtrax Mini mount to it's corresponding holes on the Centre Hub Mount bracket. Using the supplied nut, bolt and washers, secure the Maxtrax Mini mount to the Centre Hub bracket.





Installation cont.

- 11. Using the supplied nut and bolt with a washer on both sides, loosely secure the Centre Hub bracket to it's mount.
- 12. With the bracket loosely attached confirm that everything clears through the doors full range of motion, then tighten fully.
- 13. Load on your Maxtrax, lock them in place using the pins and you're ready to hit the road!
