




It all works together.

Our Out-Back Mounting System is designed to work together, but there is an order to installing based on the mount you are using for your spare wheel.

The order of installation for accessories will vary depending on which mount you use.

Let's get to work.

Preparation

 Remove the factory spare wheel, so that the spare wheel studs are exposed.






Installation

- 2. Slide the Hub Mount Bracket over the spare wheel studs.
- Refit the spare wheel so the Hub Mount Bracket protrudes from the wheel's centre bore.
- Check that the Hub Mount Bracket is sitting level, and tighten the spare wheel's bolts.
- Before attaching the Hub Sliding Bracket to the Hub Mount Bracket, consider what accessories you intend to attach and in what orientation. It is best to loosely position the Hub Sliding Bracket to work our your ideal configuration.
 - Depending on what accessory you have mounted, you may want the Hub Sliding Bracket and fitted accessory to sit hard against the tyre (e.g. Maxtrax board) or nested inside the rim (e.g. Rotopax or jerry can).
- We recommend attaching additional accessories prior to completing installation of the Centre Hub Mount, as bolt access is more difficult once the Hub Sliding Bracket is fitted.








Finishing the installation

If you are also installing other Out-Back Accessories:

7. Refer to those instructions to complete your installation.

If you are <u>only</u> installing the Centre Hub Mount:

- Place the sliding mount over the hub mount and locate it to the wheel.
- With location established use the supplied M8 bolts and washers to secure the sliding mount on either side. If you're securing something hard against the tyre, be sure to keep pressure on this while tightening.
- 10. With the Centre Hub Mount installed, you are now ready to use it as a platform for mounting accessories on your rear spare wheel!
